The bulk of our food rescue and distribution work is through the evening and early mornings so we would like the base to be used as an educational resource throughout the day, where people can learn more about food waste and ways to prevent it, run classes for groups, learning about how to improve health while preventing waste; and also provide a safe, non judgemental space for those looking to collect free food.

We would also like to train volunteers to go and speak to schools and community groups about food waste, sharing their own experiences and open up the larger conversation, change attitudes and perceptions. This is something we have already done on a small scale, presenting at school assemblies and working with small groups to make simple meal items using surplus food at health weeks and we would love to expand this program
